

NOOSA DISTRICT BASKETBALL ASSOCIATION (NOOSA CYCLONES) BEHAVIOURAL TECHNICAL FOUL-EJECTION POLICY AND PROCEDURES



Overview

In keeping with the Codes of Behaviour for Noosa Cyclones and Basketball Queensland, the use of obscene language, abuse or unacceptable behaviour is strictly prohibited and will not be tolerated!

The Noosa Cyclones Committee wish to eliminate poor behaviour by enforcing tough penalties on any players or coaches who receive a Technical Foul for offensive or abusive language and behaviour that brings the game into disrepute.

Action

Behavioural Technical Foul – Definition:

A technical foul is a player non-contact foul of a behavioural nature including, but not limited to:

- Disrespectfully communicating with the referees, the referee co-ordinator/supervisor, the court controller or the opponent.
- Using language, actions or gestures likely to offend or incite.

Any obscenity or dissent whether at another player, official, coach or yourself will result in a Technical Foul.

Notification:

The Referee will action the Technical Foul on player or coach:

- Player automatically serves 5mins on bench, player can be replaced. Time does not include timeouts or breaks.
- Coach-no time penalty

Technical Foul to be recorded in Basketball Connect.

If Technical Foul requires ejection or report, Referee or Court Controller or Referee Supervisor complete, Report Sheet and forward to Operations Manager.

Operations Manager enters details on Basketball Connect.

***A 'Double Technical Foul' or 'Second Technical Foul' in the same game will result in Player or Coach being automatically ejected from the current game and automatic suspension from the Club for ONE week. Further disciplinary action may be taken.**

Penalties

PLAYERS/COACHES

First (1) Technical Foul (Behavioural)

- Any Player/Coach that receives 1 (1st) Technical Foul in a NDBA game will receive a recorded Technical Foul in Basketball Connect and miss 5mins of game time.
- This will act as the first warning.

Subsequent Technical Fouls (Behavioural)

- Any Player/Coach that receives subsequent technical fouls may receive further disciplinary action.
- This will be recorded in Basketball Connect.

Penalty dates are not able to be changed!

A 'Double Technical Foul' in the one game will result in automatic ejection and suspension from the Club for ONE week. This includes any games or coaching. Person may spectate from upstairs.

All records will be reset at the end of each NDBA season! However, suspensions will carry over if not fully served.
